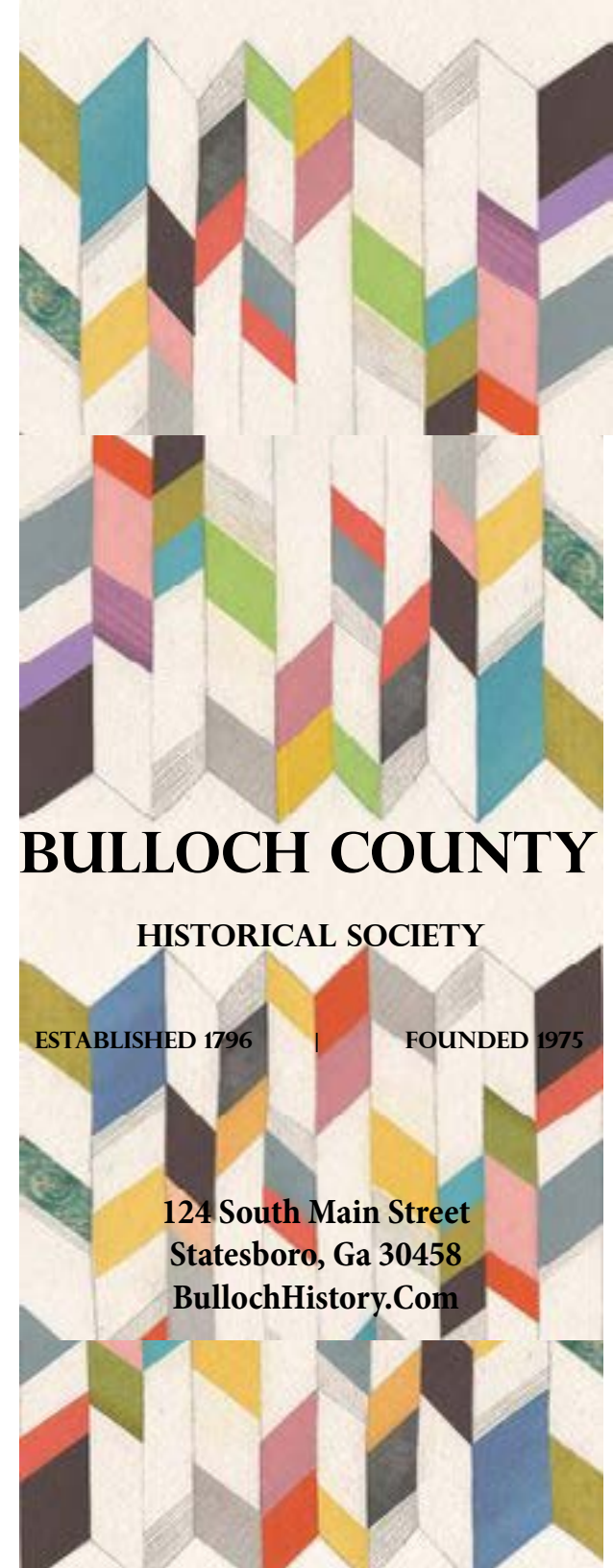

A magical cart in a cotton field hosted by Russel Scarecrow and his pal, Jim, is the site of the live broadcast, joined by prominent historical figures from all over time and space, including Eleanor Roosevelt, Hernando DeSoto and Blind Willie McTell.
